Arrival Instructions:

Participants should fly into Redmond Oregon (RDM) as this is the closest airport to us. Participants should fly into a major airport such as Seattle, WA (SEA) or Portland, Oregon (PDX) and take a connecting flight to RDM. As an alternative, participants can fly into Portland, OR (PDX) and take a bus from the airport to Redmond Oregon (the bus takes a few hours and goes over the Cascade Mountain range).

Please communicate your travel details to us at least 7 days prior to arrival.

Participants should plan to arrive Monday thru Friday from 8am to 8pm. We will be happy to arrange for transportation from Redmond OR to the ranch Monday - Friday. The travel time is about 35 minutes from the airport or the bus station to the Ranch. There is NO cost for transportation! Once we pick up participants, we will stop at a grocery store so participants can stock up on the basics before arriving at the Ranch.

If participants arrive after 8pm or on Saturday or Sunday, they will need to arrange for a hotel room at their own expense and we will pick up the next work day (Monday - Friday).

PLACEMENT INFORMATION

Job Description:

General Summary: To clean and sanitize all non-disposable kitchen utensils, flatware and china, and ensure cleanliness of work area, dishwashing machine and refuse areas. Maintain correct amount of chemicals to ensure proper cleaning of all cooking and eating utensils.

Essential Functions/Major Responsibilities:

- 1. Know how to operate dishwashing machine to insure cleanliness of dishware.
- 2. Clean dishware in a timely manner so as not to run out of any needed items.
- 3. Know health code standards required by law that pertain to dishwashing.
- 4. Know where all kitchenware is kept and keep those areas clean and orderly.

Other Functions:

- 1. Empty garbage as needed.
- 2. Break down boxes.

- 3. Sort bottles so they are ready for pickup.
- 4. Keep back loading dock area clean and in orderly fashion.
- 5. Help put stock away when needed.

Specific Job Skills: Must be able to communicate and comprehend in the English language. Must have adequate motor skills to prevent frequent dishware breakage.

Education and/or Experience: This job does not require previous experience. High school education is helpful but not necessary.

Job Conditions: Cleaning of dirty dishes in an area where the floors are damp and hands will be frequently in water. Dishware will be hot after cleaning and there will be a lot of steam coming from hot dishes. Must be able to lift and move up to 75 pounds. Job requires standing 4-8 hours per day, 20 to 40 hours per week.

Job Complexity/Supervisory Responsibility: It is essential that the Dishwasher is organized and puts cleaned items away in their proper place. Dishwasher must maintain cleanliness of dishwashing machine and insure proper operating temperatures and proper chemical flow into machine. Instructs other employees on proper placement of dirty dishes in dish area.

Interpersonal Contacts: Interacts with other Food & Beverage employees on a one-on-one, face-to-face, simple information exchange. Would usually consist of informing employees of any changes in dishwashing procedures that would pertain to them.
