ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Arrival Instructions:

The following information is very important for your arrival into Myrtle Beach:

Pacific is happy to provide transportation from the airport and/or bus terminal to the designated location, but it is very important to communicate all necessary details regarding your scheduled arrival. Further information is included for arrival after hours.

Once you have arrived into the Myrtle Beach, South Carolina area:

- 1: Flight details and/or arrival details should be provided to Aviv and Shirrie 2 weeks prior to your scheduled arrival so that proper arrangements may be made.
- 2: You will need to contact Aviv and Shirrie as soon as you arrive (Contact Information will be provided upon hiring), no matter your arrival time, provided that further instructions were not given prior to your arrival.
 - The airport has Wifi, so be sure to connect to the wifi on your cellular device or other devices, as you will most likely need to contact us through an app called WhatsApp.
 - Provided that you are unable to connect with Aviv or Shirrie, within 1 hour of your arrival, for further instructions, you will need to do one of the following:
 - If your arrival is Monday Friday, 8:00AM 7:00PM, EST; We will pick you up from the Airport and take you where you need to go.
 - If your arrival is outside of our normal business hours (Monday-Friday after 7:00PM, Sunday after 7pm, or if you arrive anytime on Saturday) you will need to access transportation, at your expense, to a hotel over night. Further details will be provided

upon hire.

- Please try to arrive any day but Saturday
- The most simple form of transportation to either of the above locations is with an UBER. The cost is usually \$20-\$30. Both locations are only a few minutes away from the Myrtle Beach airport.
- 3: Once you have arrived, further information will be provided to you for housing (keys, transportation to housing location, etc.). This information will also be discussed with you upon hiring.

It is VERY important that you show up on time and do the work you are assigned. We have a very low tolerance for people that are late or do not do their work well.

Things to understand when joining our team:

- 1. If there is an issue within the few days of arrival, we ask that you communicate with us you concerns. It is important that you understand the consequences of leaving without notice and without communicating. so please let us know if there is any problems. If not, It can lead to your visa being shortened or your return back home. You must concolidate with your agent and with us if you don't follow the present protocols.
- 2. If you get a second Job, their schedule cannot cross with the schedule we provide you. Keep in mind, we create schedule every week so your schedule most likely will change in times every week. However, we offer a lot of opportunity to work more hours and make more money.
