Arrival Instructions:

We don't require a specific day of the week to arrive, we would prefer you not to arrive at housing after 9 pm. The closest airport to Mackinaw City is Pellston (PLN), approximately 14 miles away, with shuttle service available through Mackinaw Shuttle. However, we might be able to pick you up at Pellston Airport depending on flight times. The next closest airport is either Chippewa County International (CIU), 50 miles away, or Traverse City Cherry Capital Airport (TVC), 80 miles away. For these last two airports, you would have to find transportation to Mackinaw City, either by bus or Northern Transport and shuttle. If you fly into Detroit, (300 miles) you will have to take the Indian Trails bus to Mackinaw City.

There is a public transportation bus that will take you to a couple of the bigger cities for more shopping options if needed. This information is posted in our housing common rooms.

We will be taking you to the Social Security office to apply for your Social Security card at the appropriate time.

We provide polo shirts, and fleece jackets, we ask that you provide your own khaki colored (tan) pants. Shorts can be worn, but they need to be knee length and also khaki in color. Comfortable walking shoes, tennis shoes work best, no sandals. Any offensive tatoos need to be covered while working, need to have clean neat hair and uniform, no excessive jewelry.

We provide break areas with a refrigerator, and microwave for you to bring your lunch to work. We ask that you leave your backpack, purse, bag, etc. in the secured breakroom. We also ask that you leave your cell phone in your bag in the breakroom. Cell phones are not permitted on the work floor unless you have prior permission from the sales manager. Schedules are posted in two-week increments. Breaks are calculated by the hours you are scheduled, for example if you are scheduled for an 8 hour shift you will get two 15 min breaks (paid) with 1/2 lunch (unpaid). There are dedicated smoking areas, and you are only allowed to smoke during your break time.
