Arrival Instructions:

The Crown of the Continent Discovery Center can be accessed via plane flying into Glacier Park International Airport in Kalispell, MT (airport code FCA) or via train to West Glacier on Amtrak. The airport is a 45 minute drive from the Discovery Center in West Glacier and the Amtrak station is a 2 minute drive. Students are required to arrive one full day before they start work to allow for transportation and time to settle in.

A car is required to get into town (Kalispell) where the large shops and the social security office and the airport are all located. Some stores and attractions are accessible via foot or bike in West Glacier and there is a shuttle system inside the Park that operates from July through early September and offers free transportation along Going to the Sun Road. It's about three miles from the Discovery Center to the transit center where the shuttle departs from.

Swan Mountain Outfitters will pick employees up from the train or the airport on arrival. Additionally, we will coordinate one initial trip into town to set up a bank account, apply for a social security card and purchase supplies. We offer full room and board for a small monthly fee which includes a weekly delivery of groceries from an approved ingredients list.

Front of House Bartender/Cashier Employee must obtain knowledge of products that we sell (i.e., gifts, logo wear, beers & spirits, snacks, ice cream, espresso and bar drinks, etc.), keep the store area clean at all times and help to re-stock merchandise.
