### PLACEMENT INFORMATION

**Job Description:**

Fun City is seeking outgoing individuals to fill our ride attendant positions. New hires will be trained in the safety of each ride that they will work at Fun City. These rides include go-karts, bumper boats, a roller coaster, a bungee trampoline, a slide, water balls, and gel blasters. Once staff have been trained on the rides, they will be helping customers on and off of rides, explaining safety rules to the customers, monitoring the ride while it is in action, making sure customers are obeying ride rules, scanning customers' ride cards, and also just helping with keeping the ride operating safely and smoothly.

Your English will need to be advanced to convey the rules and safety issues to customers.

**Typical Schedule:**

We open daily from mid-May to the middle of September. We are open from 10a - 8p for 90% of those days. Mid-Sept-end of Oct will be

weekends only because everyone is back in school.

We will be open full-time on May 16th. Hours before May 16th will be limited. We drop to part-time hours after Sept 13th, at which point hours will be reduced.

Our Bungee trampoline ride is allowed to put out a tip jar. The tips from this ride are usually split up between the staff operating the ride that day. All other rides are not tipped.

For those working on the bungee trampoline, this ride requires a little more physical strength. That is why these employees make tips as customers see what it takes to operate this ride. Trampoline staff also get the first right of refusal for some of the extra jobs that might be available. ie, blowing off the golf courses every morning and cleaning the bathrooms and building before opening for additional hours. Pushing is required when working with Go Karts.

The house has room for 10 employees and we will do a first come first served for those spots. There are 2 common areas, one upstairs and one down stairs. They both have satellite TV's. There are two large decks to enjoy the mountain views that have patio furniture and also a gas grill. The kitchen is fully stocked with all cooking utensils like pots and pans. Also plates, silverware and all necessary kitchen items. Blender, toaster, coffee maker, microwave, dishwasher, refrigerator, second refrigerator/freezer in the garage, and a small bar style fridge in the basement. There are 5 bedrooms and 3 full bathrooms. Each bedroom has 2 beds in it, closet and places to store clothes (shelves in closets or dressers). Also ceiling fans in each room. There is a washer and dryer, and iron and ironing board. Towels and linens for the beds are provided. The house address is 1820 Ranch Circle Drive, Estes Park, CO 80517. The housing cost includes transportation to and from work.
