

Thundering Surf Waterpark - Shallow water lifeguard

Company Description:

Thundering Surf is a family operated family entertainment center featuring a waterpark and a 36 hole adventure golf course located in a beach resort town called Bach Haven, in Long Beach Island, NJ. Our waterpark features attractions including 6 water slides, a Lazy Crazy River, a 4 lane Racer slide, an interactive water play structure for children and also a Toddler water play area, and a simulated wave riding attraction called the Flow rider double. Our Adventure Golf includes two 18 hole golf courses with beautiful landscaping. The summer season is very busy with tourists and visitors on summer break. Our park is located in the (hub) where the majority of activity happens on the island. This includes shopping, restaurants, cafes, local markets, breweries and bars. There is a theater that schedules performances each week and an ice cream showcase attraction which is very popular with the visitors and the residents on the island, the climate is typical of the New Jersey shore area. The temperatures typically range between 80 F - 90F. Any cultural events that are scheduled during the summer months will be announced for the international community so that they may attend. There are Festivals, and national holiday celebrations which feature firework displays. There are art shows, kite show events, and concerts with local bands that perform. The Barnegat light house is a popular icon that attracts visitors accessible via the island shuttle, bicycle or automobile

The lifeguard candidate must exhibit the ability to use the 4 basic rescue skills if necessary in the event a rescue from any of the water attractions. Also candidate must demonstrate basic life support using the technique of CPR(cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation) and AR (Artificial Respiration). The candidate must learn the waterpark policies in order to enforce the rules of safety of all guests inside the waterpark. The candidate must learn all emergency procedures to ensure safety in and out of the water.

The schedule is based on a maximum of a 40 hour work week, maximum 8 hour day with a 30 minute unpaid break each day scheduled.

The sweatpants and sweatshirt provided are purchased by the individual and also the water resistant windbreaker (Optional)

Our housing consists of 2 apartments on the same property as our waterpark at 300 Taylor Ave, Beach Haven, NJ. One apartment located at 806 North Bay Ave, Beach Haven, NJ can accommodate maximum 8 people and the other apartment located at 300 Taylor Ave, Beach Haven, NJ can accommodate maximum 12 people. The weekly rent is \$120 USD. Provided in this rental fee are all utilities, such as WiFi, Cable Television, gas and electric, and air conditioning. All bath and bed linens are supplied. There are two bathrooms. There are fully equipped kitchens. Laundry options located in one apartment and the additional washing machine and dryer are located in the second floor of the building located at the waterpark. A rental agreement will be provided upon arrival for all to read and understand. This agreement must be signed the day you move in. We do not allow smoking or vaping inside of the apartments. If you smoke you must do this outside of the building and dispose of your cigarette butts in a cigarette tray. All occupants must make a team effort to keep the rooms, the kitchens and the bathrooms clean. NO Parties are allowed in our apartments at any time. The contract will include a more extensive list of policies and rules.

General job conditions include the understanding that the waterpark remains open during rain events, unless a thunderstorm causes unsafe conditions. All lifeguards are given job expectations for their positions so they understand and are willing to work in certain weather conditions. Cell phones are not allowed at the employee work stations, zero tolerance. Smoking or vaping is not allowed in the waterpark or inside the apartments or the main building. Any one who smokes must smoke outside the apartments and the rooms and if working their shift, smoking can be done when taking a break, which is unpaid time.
